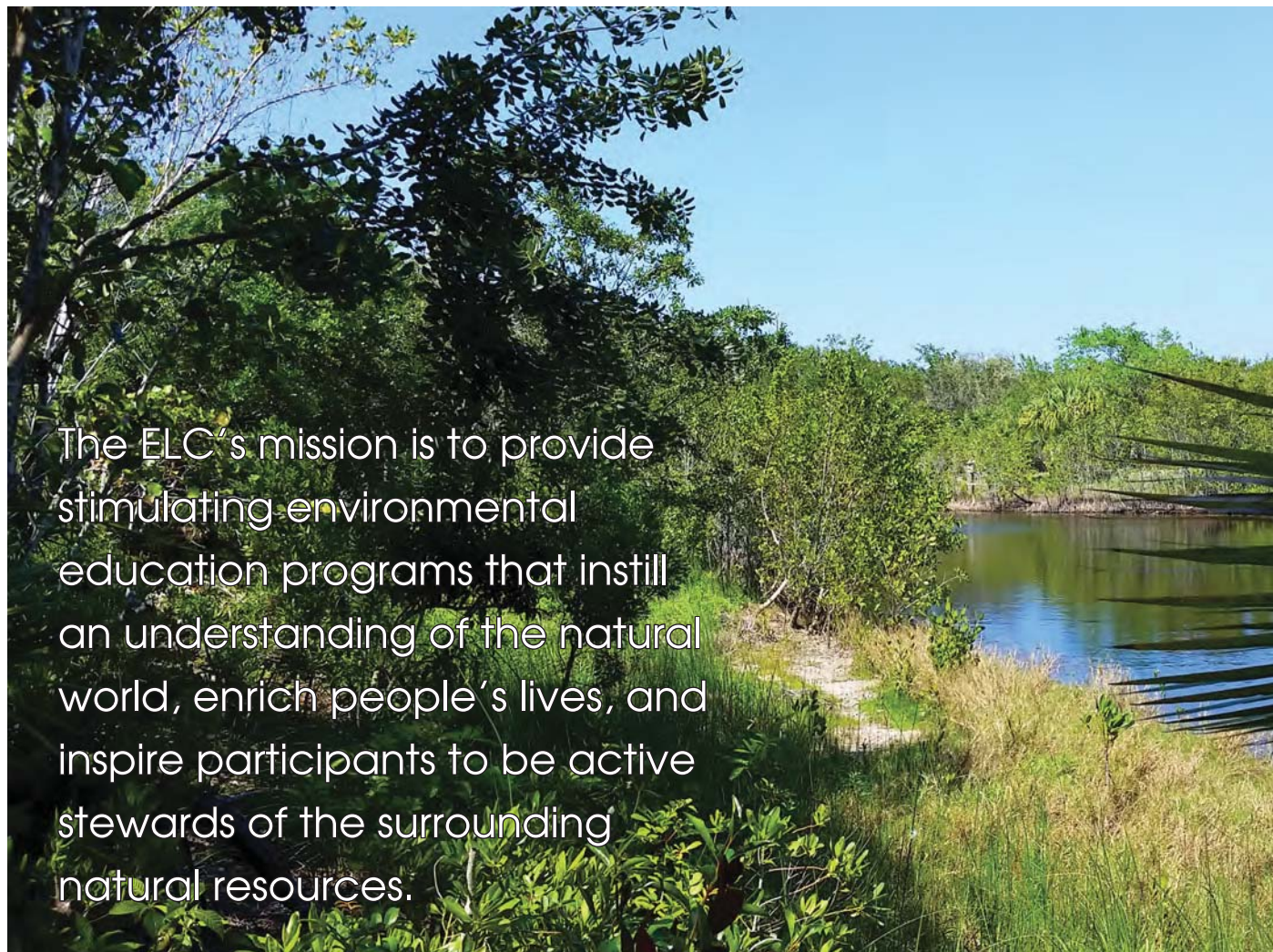

We are delighted to welcome Molly Steinwald as our new executive director. Molly is passionate about fostering environmental education and focusing on the linkage between environmental stewardship and human well-being. Molly will be a wonderful asset to the ELC and the Treasure Coast community.

During the past year, we have laid the groundwork to expand our impact in the community by launching our “Livin’ for the Lagoon” educational campaign. The program focuses on influencing behavior changes that can positively impact the environment around us, particularly the Indian River Lagoon – North America’s most diverse estuary. With support from the Indian River Community Foundation, we launched the first campaign segment last year. Working directly with sixteen property/ homeowner associations, the ELC has provided hands-on training to demonstrate both the economic and environmental value of adopting Florida-friendly landscape practices in each community. The program has been extremely well received.

From leading the area’s only Florida Master Naturalist certification series, to holding classes on our floating classroom – the pontoon boat “Discover,” to working with homeowner associations and golf courses, the ELC works closely with not just children, but adults as well, to actively engage them in environmental stewardship.

Your support is vitally important and allows us to enrich the lives of many people while protecting and preserving our natural environment. The people and organizations listed in this publication are the reason for the success of the ELC. You are the reason we can continue to educate today as a way of preserving tomorrow.

Annual Accomplishments

Engaging Our Community

- Actively engaged and taught 3,315 elementary students in 1st, 3rd and 4th grades with SPLASH 1, SPLASH 3 and Lagoon Days classes.
- Held early childhood learning classes for a record 640 students, ages 4 – 5, who participated in the Young Explorers program with six different nature-related topics.
- Hosted 460 people through Water Ventures Learning Lab, a traveling science center that encourages positive stewardship of Florida's diverse watersheds.
- Awarded prizes to 1,896 elementary school students who created artistic entries in the Making a Difference in MY World contest that focused on the lagoon.
- Provided 435 stimulating, hands-on EcoVenture programs including hiking, boating, seining, geocaching and beachcombing.
- Awarded 93 students scholarships to attend summer ecology programs and held outdoor summer classes to 257 participants.
- Hosted state and local elected and appointed officials who attended our UpClose and Ecological program – a hands-on learning workshop to encourage policies and decisions that preserve the Indian River Lagoon.
- Kicked off “Livin’ for the Lagoon,” a hands-on, comprehensive education campaign designed to



show people how small changes in behaviors can have large effects on the Indian River Lagoon.

- Eight hundred hands were reaching across the Indian River Lagoon on National Estuaries Day to show unity and concern at our “Hands Across the Lagoon” event on the causeway adjacent to the ELC!

Volunteers Extraordinaire

- **9,479!!!** That’s how many hours our team of 200+ volunteers contributed to the community. We owe deep gratitude to those who donate their time, talents and treasures to improve our quality of life.
- **500!** That’s the number of plants that our volunteers nurtured and planted to help restore the lagoon, along with mats full of oyster shells.
